Halachic Notes

Shulchan Aruch HaRav:	The Nodah B'Yehuda (Shaila U'Teshuvos Nodah B'Yehuda - Madura Tenyana, siman 83) holds that the way in which one counts vestos haflagos is from the beginning of one period to the beginning of the next period. The Shulchan Aruch HaRav (Yoreh Deya - siman 184, sif 22) holds that a haflaga is counted from the end of one period to the beginning of the following period.
R' Dovid Tevel:	The Nodah B'Yehuda (Shaila U'Teshuvos Nodah B'Yehuda - Madura Tenyana, siman 83) brings down R' Dovid Tevel who holds that you count vestos haflagah based on the amount of onos in between the periods, rather than the amount of days. Though the Nodah B'Yehuda feels that this sevarah has a lot of merit, he ultimately paskens that it should be based on the amount of days - not like R' Dovid Tevel - since we don't find any of the Rishonim mentioning such a shitah. The Shulchan Aruch HaRav (Yoreh Deya - siman 184, sif 36), however, paskens like R' Dovid Tevel.
Beis Mayer:	The understanding of the Shach (Yora Deya - siman 189, sif katan 31) is that a shorter vest can even uproot a longer vest. The Beis Mayer (Yora Deya - siman 189, sif 14), however, disagrees and holds that a shorter vest cannot uproot a longer vest. According to the Beis Mayer in a case where a lady had a long vest and then a short vest, she now has to be choshesh for both. Which onah is she choshesh for in the long vest - the onah of the latest period, or the onah in which the long vest was created? For example, if a lady saw after 30 days at night, and then after 20 days at day, she now has to be choshesh for both 20 days and 30 days. But for the 30 day vest, which onah is she

choshesh for - day, which is the last onah in which she saw, or night, which is the onah in which her 30 day vest was created? Moreinu HaRav Yitzchok Berkovitz SHLITA holds that she is choshesh only for the last onah, so she would be choshesh for 20 days at day, and for 30 days at day.
